

HIGHER EDUCATION GRANT APPLICATION

To all STUDENTS/FINANCIAL AID OFFICERS

STUDENT

All students must submit a completed application. A completed application consists of: a ***Higher Education Grant Application form, a letter of acceptance from the college or university or proof of enrollment, a completed needs analysis, grades or official transcript*** (if requested).

All students will be required to **re-apply** for a Higher Education Grant each semester/quarter. Grant applications are available at the Tribal Education Office or online at www.wrpt.us.

All students receiving a Higher Education Grant are required to submit a copy of their grades or an official transcript at the end of each semester or quarter they are in attendance. Additional funding will not be processed until received.

All students are required to notify the Tribal Education Office immediately should they withdraw from school at anytime during the school year.

A recipient of a Higher Education Grant must be enrolled and maintain full-time status for a minimum of 12 academic units and maintain a grade point average (GPA) of at least a 2.0.

All students are required to apply for all Financial Aid programs available through the University/College Financial Aid Office. The Financial Aid Officer will complete the Financial Needs Analysis budget of the grant application and forward it to the Tribal Education Office for review. ***It is the student's responsibility to get the Financial Aid Form to the Financial Aid Officer.***

FINANCIAL AID OFFICER

The Tribal Higher Education Grant is intended to cover part of the student's unmet financial need after all other University/College funds have been utilized to complete the student's financial aid package. The Walker River Paiute Tribe has inadequate funds to fund at 100%. Please abide by all deadlines, students missing deadlines will jeopardize tribal funding. WRPT awards on a semester basis, please submit FNA's accordingly.

DEADLINES

Higher Education Grant application and completed Financial Needs Analysis should be in the Tribal Higher Education Office no later than:

Fall Semester – July 1

Spring Semester – November 1st

All students are responsible for insuring the complete application is in the Walker River Paiute Tribe Education Office by the deadline. Applications received after the deadline will not be considered.
